On the road to Prague

The mid year Prague meeting is an intense week of hard work across and among the communities. Attendance from the Business Constituency continues to grow. In Prague, we will focus on gTLD policy work; meet with the CCNSO; the ALAC, with senior staff, and with the Board, and participate in various ICANN governance sessions, with a special focus on the continuing work of the Affirmation of Commitment Review Teams, and on the operational performance of ICANN.

In Prague we expect new attendance from brand holders drawn into ICANN through the new gTLD program. They will bring with them also expectations for high standards of operational performance across all aspects of ICANN's mission and activities. It can be hard to understand ICANN's unique multi stakeholder organizational structures. Check out pages 2 and 3 of the newsletter for an update to our overview charts on ICANN's organizational structures and the Board.

In addition to all our internal work at ICANN, we also pay attention to the external challenges to the Internet and to ICANN's role and activities. External proposals vary, but include calls for inter-governmental oversight over key aspects of the Internet – including some of ICANN's functions.

We've provided a timeline of relevant events as a contribution to understanding ICANN's place in a larger eco system of interactions and activities. Many in the ICANN business community are working actively in those settings. We welcome a workshop on Monday afternoon that will provide additional useful information and insights.


It's busy days at ICANN on many fronts. Like others, we thank Rod
