## Background

This document is the response of the ICANN Business Constituency (BC) to ICANN’s public comment period on the Draft Final Report on Protection of IGO and INGO Identifiers in All gTLDs.<sup>1</sup> The BC’s comments arise from the perspective of business users, as defined in our Charter:

The mission of the Business Constituency is to ensure that ICANN policy positions are consistent with the development of an Internet that:

- promotes end-user confidence because it is a safe place to conduct business
- is competitive in the supply of registry and registrar and related services and
- is technically stable, secure and reliable.<sup>2</sup>
